Inauguration of Faculty of Food Sciences

A New Faculty of Food Sciences have been created in Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University on the recommendation of Board of Studies, Academic Council, Board of Management and with the approval of His Excellency the Governor of Tamil Nadu and Chancellor of this university. The new Faculty have been created in order to meet the requirements of the Food Processing sector with regard to technical manpower requirement, undertake specific research and development program for the benefit of Food Processing sector and to transfer the technologies for adoption for the value addition of various foods such as milk, meat, egg, chicken, cereals, pulses, fruits, vegetables, etc.

The Faculty of Food Sciences have been inaugurated on 16.09.2009 by Thiru C. Muthukumaraswamy, I.A.S., Secretary, Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Government of Tamil Nadu, under the Presidentship of Dr. P. Thangaraju, Vice-Chancellor, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (TANUVAS), Chennai-51 and in the presence of Thiru M.Malik Feroze Khan, I.A.S., Commissioner of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services, and Dr. G. Thulasi, Dean in-charge, Faculty of Food Sciences, TANUVAS, and Dr. Daniel Joy Chandran, Registrar, TANUVAS and other University officers of TANUVAS.

A four year B.Tech degree programme in Food Processing Technology (FPT) approved by the AICTE, is being offered at the Institute of Food and Dairy Technology, Koduvalli. The students of the B.Tech programme are imparted with practical knowledge to meet the requirements of food processing industries such as milk, meat, chicken, egg, cereals, pulses and also other foods. They are also provided with knowledge and skills in the area of the quality control, Hazard Analysis Critical Control Point (HACCP), value addition and packaging.

The meritorious students of final year Food Processing Technology will undergo training in the Final Semester in the University of Nebraska, U.S.A. The Faculty of Food Sciences have been created with Dr. G. Thulasi as the First Dean in-charge of the Faculty of Food Sciences, Tamil Nadu Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Chennai-51.
