2. Calves above 3 months and sheep and goat above 2 months should be vaccinated against Foot and Mouth disease.
3. Clean drinking water should be provided for the broiler birds to avoid Coliform infection.

Special Advisory for Agriculture & Horticulture (Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Virinjipuram, Vellore Dist.)

1. Conserve moisture in the field using Coir pith mulch/ Straw mulch.
2. Control rice blast by applying recommended fungicides
3. Manage muranai disease in Chilli by controlling the vector by spraying dimethoat or dicofol 2ml/lit.

1. Present weather condition favour spread of Blast disease in Paddy. Foliar application of Pseudomonas Florescens @ 400g/acre or Tricyclazole @ 120g/acre can be applied to avoid spread of this disease.
2. Second weeding should be followed for groundnut crops and apply gypsum @ 160 kg/Acre
